

#### PUBLIC CHAPTER NO. 459

**HOUSE BILL NO. 488**

Substituted for: Senate Bill No. 1257

By Senator Norris

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 6, Chapter 19, relative to authorizing a fee to fund municipal fire departments.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 6-19-101, is amended by designating the existing language as subsection (a) and adding the following as a new subsection (b):

#### Fire Services

- Lakeland Fire Department begins service on July 1, 2019
- Full time, paid firefighters, supplemented by part- time fire fighters
- Ambulance Contract with Shelby County will not change
- Plan to Phase out Fire Fee







#### From Moody's:

The "Aa3" rating is described as high-quality and very low credit risk. The rating reflects the city's strong financial position marked by solid reserve levels, moderately-sized and affluent tax base, and slightly elevated debt profile which amortizes rapidly.

According to Moody's, an obligor with an Aa3 rating has "very strong capacity to meet its financial commitments. It differs from the highest-rated obligors only to a small degree."
